FIELD PROJECTS: Attached is the updated list provided by Randy and Israel.

PICKLEBALL COURTS: Will open July 6, with a grand opening planned in the Fall, when most of our Spring Lake Pickleball Club members return from the north. The Sebring Pickleball Club will provide free beginner lessons at a three-day clinic, July 18, 20, and 22, from 8:00 a.m. until 9:30 a.m.

MOWING: Two part-time workers have been hired for all mowing tasks. Both live in Spring Lake.

PUBLIC HEARING: A very important meeting that requires attendance by all Supervisors. This August 9 hearing will discuss the proposed FY '24 budget, including all assessments; utility rates and fees; out of district utility fees; and out of district stormwater maintenance fees. A notice will appear two times in the News-Sun; the SLPA will post it in their July newsletter; and there was an e-mail blast to over 1,300 users June 29 and another will go out August 1.

UTILITY UPDATE: We currently serve 1,729 water customers and 318 wastewater customers for a total of 2,047 utility connections. There have been 11 meters purchased but not yet connected, and 84 projected connections between the apartments, cabins, and single-family homes. During the next fiscal year we will be over 2,100 utility connections.
